■ Crochet Corgi Appliqué Tutorial for Absolute Beginners

This beginner-friendly crochet tutorial will teach you how to make an adorable Corgi dog appliqué. It's an easy and fun project that uses basic stitches — perfect for learning crochet while making something cute! You can attach this appliqué to bags, hats, blankets, or even make keychains. Let's get started!

Materials You Will Need

- 3mm crochet hook
- Worsted weight yarn in brown (for body), white (for paws and chest), pink (for tongue), and black (for eyes and nose)
- Yarn needle for sewing and embroidery
- Scissors
- Stitch marker (optional)

Abbreviations

- ch = chain
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- sl st = slip stitch
- st(s) = stitch(es)
- inc = increase (2 stitches in same stitch)

Basic Stitch Guide

Chain (ch): Yarn over and pull through the loop on your hook.

Single Crochet (sc): Insert hook into stitch, yarn over, pull through (2 loops on hook), yarn over again and pull through both loops.

Half Double Crochet (hdc): Yarn over, insert hook into stitch, yarn over and pull through (3 loops on hook), yarn over and pull through all 3 loops.

Double Crochet (dc): Yarn over, insert hook, yarn over and pull through (3 loops on hook), yarn over and pull through two loops twice.

Slip Stitch (sl st): Insert hook into stitch, yarn over and pull through both loops on hook.

Step-by-Step Crochet Instructions

Step 1: Start with the Body (Brown Yarn)

- 1. Chain 9 stitches (ch 9).
- 2. Starting in the 2nd chain from the hook, make 1 sc in each stitch across. (8 sc)
- 3. Ch 1 and turn your work.
- 4. Continue 1 sc in each stitch across for 4 rows to form the body rectangle.
- 5. Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing.

Step 2: Head (Brown Yarn)

- 1. Attach the yarn to the top front of the body.
- 2. Ch 1, then work 2 sc, 2 hdc, 2 dc in the next stitches to round the top of the head.
- 3. Add 1 dc and 1 hdc to form the snout area.
- 4. SI st around to smooth the head shape.
- 5. Fasten off and leave a tail.

Step 3: Chest and Paws (White Yarn)

- 1. Attach white yarn at the bottom of the head where it meets the body.
- 2. Ch 1 and make 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc to form the fluffy chest.
- 3. Continue working along the bottom edge with sc and hdc to shape the paws.
- 4. Add small rounded shapes (3-4 sc in one stitch) for the paw toes.

Step 4: Ears (Brown and Pink Yarn)

- 1. With brown yarn, ch 3.
- 2. Make 1 sc, 1 hdc, and 1 dc across the chain to form a triangle shape.
- 3. Switch to pink yarn and sc around the inside edge for detail.
- 4. Make two ears and sew them on top of the head.

Step 5: Tail (Brown Yarn)

- 1. Attach yarn to the back of the body.
- 2. Ch 4 and make 1 sc in each chain.
- 3. SI st to secure and fasten off.

Step 6: Face Embroidery

- 1. Use black yarn or thread to embroider a small triangle nose.
- 2. Stitch two small eyes above the nose.
- 3. Add a little pink yarn for the tongue.
- 4. Optional: Add white stitches to highlight the eyes.



Finishing and Helpful Tips

- Weave in all yarn ends using a yarn needle.
- You can block your Corgi by placing it under a damp cloth and pressing gently.
- Add a pin back or magnet to turn it into an accessory.
- Try using different yarn colors to create various Corgi coat patterns!
