

Materials

- Small amount of red yarn (for the heart)
- Small amount of white or light pink yarn (for the wings)
- Crochet hook suitable for your yarn (usually 3.0–4.0 mm)
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

Abbreviations (US Terms)

- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- tr = treble crochet
- st(s) = stitch(es)

HEART (Red Yarn)

Round 1

Make a **magic ring**.

Inside the ring, work:

ch 2, 3 tr, 3 dc, ch 1, 1 tr, ch 1, 3 dc, 3 tr, ch 2

Then pull the ring closed firmly.

Join with **sl st** to the center of the heart.

You will see the heart shape forming immediately.

LEFT WING (Light Yarn)

Row 1:

Ch 8. Turn.

Row 2:

Starting in the 2nd ch from the hook:
1 sc, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, 1 dc, 1 tr.
Turn.

Row 3:

Ch 2.
Work across:
1 sc, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, 1 dc, 1 tr.
Fasten off.

RIGHT WING (Light Yarn)

Make the same steps as the left wing:

Row 1:

Ch 8. Turn.

Row 2:

1 sc, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, 1 dc, 1 tr.
Turn.

Row 3:

Ch 2.
Work again:
1 sc, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, 1 dc, 1 tr.
Fasten off.

Assembly

1. Place one wing on each side of the heart.
2. Sew the wings to the back of the heart using a yarn needle.
3. Weave in all loose ends.

Optional: glue or sew onto a hair clip, bag, or gift box.
