



A cute, reusable bunny-shaped pocket perfect for holding cutlery, napkins, or small treats. Ideal for Easter, kids' tables, or cozy home décor.

Materials Needed

Cotton fabric (outer): ½ yard

Cotton fabric (lining): ½ yard

Thin fusible interfacing (optional for structure)

Small pom-pom for the bunny tail

Matching thread

Pins or clips

Sewing machine + iron

Pattern Pieces & Measurements (inches)

Measurements taken directly from your grid pattern ($\frac{3}{8}$ " seam allowance included).

1. Bunny Body (Cut 2 on fold)

Total height: 11¼ in

Body width: 7¼ in

Ear height: 3½ in

Neck width: 2 in

2. Cutlery Pocket (Cut 1×)

Height: 5 in

Width: 6½ in

Curved upper opening to fit neatly over the body.

3. Pom-Pom Tail

Suggested size: 1¼ in diameter

Step-By-Step Sewing Instructions

★ 1. Prepare the Bunny Body

Cut 2 body pieces on the fold (outer fabric + lining).

Optional: Fuse lightweight interfacing to the outer layer for better structure.

Place the two pieces right sides together and pin.

★ 2. Sew the Body Shape

Sew around the entire bunny silhouette (ears, sides, rounded bottom).

Leave a 3–4 in opening at the lower edge for turning.

Clip curves and the inner ear corners for a smooth finish.

Turn right side out and press well.

★ 3. Prepare the Cutlery Pocket

Cut 1 pocket piece from outer fabric (interface if desired).

Fold the top curved edge toward the wrong side by $\frac{1}{2}$ in, press, and sew.

Place the pocket centered on the bunny body (lining side up).

Align the bottom and side edges of the pocket with the body.

★ 4. Attach the Pocket

Sew pocket sides and bottom onto the bunny front layer only.

Backstitch at the start and end for strength.

Optional: Add decorative trim along the pocket top.

★ 5. Close the Body

Fold the backing layer behind the body.

Close the turning gap with a ladder stitch or topstitch around the outer edge for reinforcement.

★ 6. Add the Bunny Tail

Hand-sew the pom-pom to the back lower center of the bunny.

Make sure it is secure — especially if the item will be used around children.

☀️ Style & Sewing Tips

Soft pastel cottons (baby blue, cream, blush) create the sweetest results.

Adding small pom-pom trim across the pocket gives a festive look.

Use fusible fleece for a padded, luxury version.

You can also turn this into a gift pouch by adding a small ribbon loop at the top.

Perfect for Easter table setting, kids' birthdays, and farmhouse-style décor.
