



Cute Triangular Mouse

Final dimensions: ~45–55 cm long (depending on stuffing)

Level: Easy Beginner

Style: Bed comforter, very fluffy, perfect for children and décor.

Materials Needed

- Soft main fabric (minky, fleece, short faux fur): 50 × 70 cm
- Contrasting fabric for inside of ears: 20 × 20 cm
- White felt + black felt (eyes)
- One small pink felt (or fabric) ball for the nose
- Polyester fiberfill
- Assorted threads
- Needles, scissors, pins
- A cord or sewn fabric strip for the tail (included in the pattern)

Pattern Pieces Provided

- Triangular body — Cut 1 (furry fabric)
- Belly / Back — Cut 1 (furry fabric)
- Outer ear — Cut 2
- Inner ear — Cut 2
- Tail — Cut 1 (long strip)
- Eyes — Cut 2 (white) + pupils
- Nose — Cut 1 (round)
- Front legs — Cut 4 (2 legs × 2 pieces)
- Back legs — Cut 4 (2 legs × 2 pieces)



Detailed Instructions

1 Preparing the Ears

- Place outer ear and inner ear right sides together.
- Sew around the edge, leaving a small opening.
- Turn right side out and gently press.
- Topstitch if you want a sharper edge.
- Slightly fold the base of the ear to give it a rounded shape.

2 Legs

- Sew the leg pieces together in pairs, right sides together.
- Turn right side out.
- Lightly stuff (not too much!).
- Close the opening by hand.

3 Tail

- Fold the strip lengthwise in half.
- Sew along the length.
- Turn right side out (a knitting needle can help).
- Lightly stuff if you want a firmer tail.

4 Triangular Body Assembly

- Place the triangular body piece with the ears along the top edge:
 - Position ears facing inward, bases aligned.
- Attach the tail at the bottom of the triangle, pointing inward.

- Add front and back legs in the indicated positions.
- Place the belly fabric on top, right sides together.
- Sew all around the edge, leaving an opening (usually on the back).
- Trim the corners.

5 Turning & Stuffing

- Carefully turn the body right side out.
- Stuff gradually:
 - ✓ Start with the head
 - ✓ Then move forward
- Adjust the filling to keep a soft triangular shape.
- Close the opening using an invisible stitch.

6 Face

- Attach the round nose.
- Sew or glue felt eyes (white + pupils).
- Add whiskers and details with black thread if you want a cartoon effect.

✨ Pro Tips

- This pattern is perfect with very soft furry fabric: it hides small imperfections.
- For an extra playful look, make the eyes slightly asymmetrical like in the model.
- A giant version (80–90 cm) is adorable for a baby.
- Add rice inside the nose tip for a slightly weighted, stable comforter effect.
