



Bunny Kids Pouf – Comfort and Whimsy

This adorable **bunny-shaped pouf** adds a warm and playful touch to any child's bedroom. Serving as a **seat, reading cushion, and decorative accent**, it is soft, easy to clean, and fully customizable with your favorite fabrics. 

Finished Dimensions

- Height (including ears): **52 cm (20.5 in)**
- Width: **35 cm (13.8 in)**
- Length: **60 cm (23.6 in)**

Materials Needed

- **Main fabric:** cotton canvas, heavy linen, or velvet (1.50 × 1 m / 59 × 39 in)
- **Inner ear fabric:** printed cotton (30 × 40 cm / 12 × 16 in)
- **Matching piping (optional):** 2.5 m (98 in)
- **Stuffing:** polyester fiberfill or polystyrene beads – approx. **250 L**
- **Matching thread + heavy-duty needle**
- **Zipper:** 45–50 cm (18–20 in), to allow removal and washing of the cover
- **White pom-pom for the tail** (or handmade alternative)

Pattern Pieces

(1 cm / $\frac{3}{8}$ in seam allowances included)

- **Main body (x1):** 108 × 35 cm (42.5 × 13.8 in)
- **Side panels (x2):** 35 × 35 cm (13.8 × 13.8 in), slightly rounded at the top
- **Ears (x4):** 32 × 14 cm (12.6 × 5.5 in) each
- **Pom-pom or tail (x1)**

Sewing Instructions

1. Prepare the Ears

- Place one outer ear piece and one inner ear piece right sides together.
- Sew around the edges, leaving the base open.
- Turn right side out, press, and topstitch **0.5 cm (1/4 in)** from the edge.

- Fold the base in half to create a natural pleat and secure with a stitch.

2. Assemble the Body

- If using piping, attach it all around the two side panels before sewing.
- Sew the ears to the top of the front panel, right sides together.
- Pin the two side panels to the main body piece (the large rectangle).
- Stitch along the edges to form a closed tube.

3. Close the Base

- Attach the zipper along the bottom length of the pouf.
- Sew the bottom panel carefully in place.
- Turn the pouf right side out.

4. Finishing and Stuffing

- Fill with fiberfill or beads, depending on the desired firmness.
- Close the zipper securely.
- Sew or glue the pom-pom onto the back of the pouf.



Style & Tips

- For a **Scandinavian look**, choose beige linen with Liberty-style cotton ears.
- For a **playful version**, mix colorful stripes or animal-print fabrics.
- Add a **discreet back handle** to make the pouf easy to move.
