

# Crochet Dragon Scarf

(Copyright-Free Pattern)



Long dragon scarf with a shaped head at one end, textured body with spikes, and a tapered tail at the other end.

**Skill Level: Easy–Intermediate**

**Finished Length: ~140–160 cm (adjustable)**

## MATERIALS

- Worsted weight yarn (Category 4)
- Main color (MC): Green / Brown / Blue (for dragon body)
- Contrast color (CC): Cream / Yellow (for spikes & details)
- 4.5 mm crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Stitch marker
- Small amount of fiberfill

## DRAGON HEAD

(Worked in rounds)

- Round 1: MR, 6 sc (6)  
 Round 2: inc all (12)  
 Round 3: (sc, inc) x6 (18)  
 Round 4: (2 sc, inc) x6 (24)  
 Rounds 5–7: sc around (24)  
 ➤ Insert eyes between Rounds 5–6  
 ➤ Lightly stuff.  
 Round 8: (2 sc, dec) x6 (18)  
 Round 9: (sc, dec) x6 (12)  
 Flatten opening and sc across to close.

## ABBREVIATIONS

(US TERMS)

- ch – chain
- sc – single crochet
- hdc – half double crochet
- inc – increase (2 sts in same st)
- dec – decrease (sc2tog)
- sl st – slip stitch
- st(s) – stitch(es)

## SCARF BODY

1. Attach yarn to bottom of head.
2. Row 1: ch 1, sc 10
3. Row 2–120: ch 1, turn, sc 10

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1. Attach yarn to bottom of head.
  2. Row 1: ch 1, sc 10
  3. Row 2–120: ch 1, turn, sc 10
- Adjust length as desired.

## DRAGON BELLY

Optional

(Optional – CC Yarn)

- Attach CC yarn along underside.
- sl st evenly along scarf body
- Fasten off.

## FINISHING DETAILS

- Embroider nostrils on head
- Add small felt or crocheted teeth If desired
- Light steam block for smooth finish

## DRAGON TAIL

(Worked in rows)

- Row 1: ch 1, sc 8  
 Row 2: ch 1, dec, sc 4, dec (6)  
 Row 3: ch 1, dec, sc 2, dec  
 Row 4: ch 1, dec (twice) (2)  
 Fasten off.
