



Compact knitting bag – practical, clean, and elegant

A thoughtfully designed pouch for knitting and crochet lovers. Its compact size allows you to carry a working yarn ball while knitting directly from the bag. Clean lines and a minimalist shape offer a comfortable grip, making it perfect for both home use and on-the-go crafting.



Materials Needed

Fabrics

- **Main fabric:** cotton canvas, linen, lightweight denim, or sturdy cotton
- **Lining (optional but recommended):** lightweight cotton

Notions

- Matching sewing thread
- Fabric label (optional)
- Lightweight to medium fusible interfacing (optional, depending on desired structure)

Tools

- Sewing machine
 - Scissors
 - Pins or fabric clips
 - Iron
 - Fabric marking pencil
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Finished Size (approx.)

- Total height: **25 cm (9.8 in)**
- Maximum width: **25 cm (9.8 in)**
- Bottom width: **20 cm (7.9 in)**
- Handle width: **13 cm (5.1 in)**

Flat, soft, and ergonomic pouch



Pattern Pieces (single shape)

Body + Handle

- **1 piece** in main fabric, cut on the fold
- **1 piece** in lining (if using a lining)

👉 **Add 1 cm ($\frac{3}{8}$ in) seam allowance all around**

Key Pattern Measurements (as per diagram)

- Total height: **25 cm**
 - Upper section (handle opening): **13 cm**
 - Center width: **25 cm**
 - Bottom width: **20 cm**
 - Soft side curves for a comfortable hand grip
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Sewing Instructions – Step by Step

1. Cutting

- Fold the fabric right sides together.
- Place the pattern on the fold.
- Cut **one** piece from the main fabric (and lining if applicable).

2. Preparation (Optional)

- Apply fusible interfacing to the main fabric for added structure.
- Attach the fabric label to the exterior before assembly.

3. Outer Assembly

- Place the two pieces right sides together.
- Sew around the entire edge, leaving a **6–8 cm (2½–3 in)** opening on one side.
- Clip the curves slightly to reduce bulk.

4. Turning

- Turn the pouch right side out through the opening.
- Shape the curves and handle carefully.
- Press thoroughly with an iron.

5. Finishing

- Close the opening with a topstitch or hand stitch.
 - Optional: topstitch around the entire edge for a clean, durable finish.
