



 **Finished dimensions (one size)**

**Height: approx. 22–24 cm**

**Width: approx. 16–18 cm**

**Thickness: thin but protective (potholder)**



## Materials needed

### Fabrics

**Main exterior fabric: printed cotton**

**Muzzle (nose) fabric: contrasting cotton**

**Inner lining: solid cotton**

**Batting or thermal wadding (potholder-specific batting recommended)**

### Details

**Small buttons or iron-on circles (eyes & nose)**

**Ribbon or fabric strip for the hanging loop**

**Fabric for the bow (decorative option)**

### Supplies

**Matching thread**

**Needle / sewing machine**

**Scissors**

**Fabric marker or pencil**

**Pins**



## Pieces to cut

### Body

**Outer body: 2 pieces**

**Inner lining: 1 piece**

**Batting: 1 piece**

### Details

**Muzzle / nose: 1 piece**

**Decorative bow:**

- 1 rectangle + 1 center strip

**Hanging loop: 1 strip**

 **Seam allowance: 0.7 to 1 cm**

 **Sewing instructions – step by step**

 **1 Quilting**

**Layer:**

- outer fabric
- batting

**Quilt with:**

- parallel straight lines
- or diamonds (as shown in the model)

**2 Muzzle appliquéd**

**Position the muzzle piece on the front**

**Secure with:**

- zigzag stitch
- or straight stitch + topstitching

**Add eyes and nose (buttons or embroidery)**

**3 Decorative bow**

**Fold the bow rectangle**

**Stitch and turn right side out**

**Tighten with the center strip**

**Secure firmly on the mouse's head**

**4 Hanging loop**

**Fold the strip in half**

**Stitch and turn right side out**

**Form a loop**

**5 Assembly**

**Place:**

- front body
- back body
- lining

**Insert the hanging loop at the top**

**Stitch all around, leaving an opening**

**Clip the curves**

**6 Finishing**

**Turn right side out**

**Close the opening with an invisible stitch**

**Lightly press (do not flatten the volume)**

**Style & pro tips**

**Quilting enhances:**

- thermal protection
- handmade look

**Looks beautiful in:**

- floral cotton
- vintage polka dots
