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## Materials

- Yarn: white, black, and pink
  - Crochet hook 2.5–3.5 mm
  - Fiberfill stuffing
  - Yarn needle
  - Scissors
  - Stitch marker (or paper clip)
  - Safety eyes or black yarn for embroidery
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## Abbreviations

- ch = chain
- sc = single crochet
- inc = increase (2 sc in the same stitch)
- dec = decrease (sc 2 together)
- sl st = slip stitch
- rnd = round
- ( ) x = repeat

👉 Work in continuous rounds (spiral).

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## Head (white)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring (6)

Rnd 2: inc x6 (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) x6 (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x6 (24)

Rnd 5–9: 24 sc

👉 Insert eyes between rounds 6 and 7.

Rnd 10: (2 sc, dec) x6 (18)

Rnd 11: (1 sc, dec) x6 (12)

Stuff firmly

Rnd 12: dec x6 (6)

Fasten off and close.

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## Body (white)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring (6)

Rnd 2: inc x6 (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) x6 (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x6 (24)

Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) x6 (30)

Rnd 6–11: 30 sc

Rnd 12: (3 sc, dec) x6 (24)

Rnd 13: (2 sc, dec) x6 (18)

Stuff

Rnd 14: (1 sc, dec) x6 (12)

Fasten off.

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## Legs (make 4 — black or pink hooves optional)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring (6)

Rnd 2: (1 sc, inc) x3 (9)

Rnd 3–6: 9 sc

Lightly stuff

Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.

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## Ears (make 2)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring (6)

Rnd 2: (1 sc, inc) x3 (9)

Rnd 3: 9 sc

Fold flat and close with sc.

Fasten off with sewing tail.

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## Horns (make 2 – beige or brown)

Rnd 1: 4 sc in magic ring (4)

Rnd 2–4: 4 sc

Do not stuff.  
Fasten off.

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## **Snout (pink – optional crocheted piece)**

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring (6)

Rnd 2: inc x6 (12)

Rnd 3: 12 sc

Fasten off and sew to the face.

Embroider nostrils with black yarn.

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## **Assembly**

1. Sew the 4 legs to the bottom of the body.
  2. Sew the head to the top of the body.
  3. Attach ears to the sides of the head.
  4. Sew horns on top of the head.
  5. Attach or embroider the snout.
  6. Add black spots using yarn or small crochet patches.
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## **Beginner Tips**

- Always use a stitch marker.
  - Stuff gradually, not all at once.
  - If holes appear, switch to a smaller hook.
  - Cotton yarn helps show stitches clearly.
