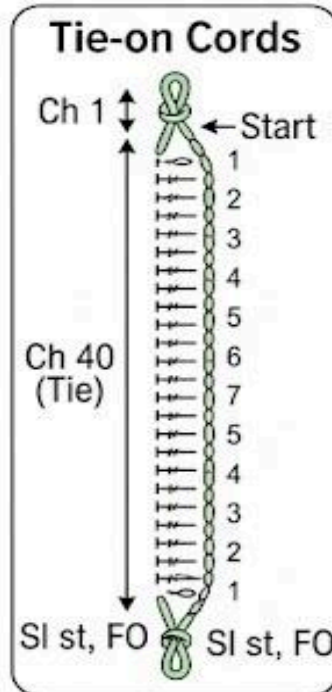


# Beautiful Bee Bracelet Crochet Pattern

## COMPLETE US CROCHET DIAGRAM FOR THE BEE BRACELET

### Single Bee Motif Detail (US Terms)

**Body:** MR (Magic Ring)

**Rnd 1:** 6 sc in MR

**Rnd 2:** inc (2 sc) in each sc (12)

**Rnd 3-8:** 6 sc in (6 sc)

2: each 3 sc) sc (12) } ■ Color

6, dec. 4-sc sc (12) } ■ Color change

3, dec(+3 sc) sc (12) } ■ 6 color change

4, dec. (3-4-) sc (13) } ■ 6 color change

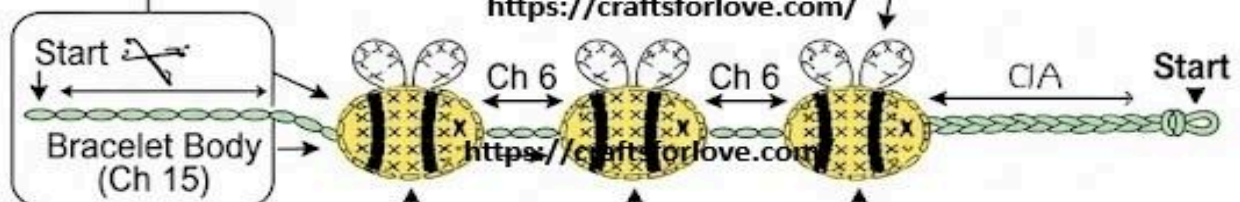
6, dec(-2 sc) sc (12) } ■ 6 color change

8, dec. 7+sc) sc (22) } ■ 6 color change

**Wings (White)**

**Wings (x2):**

Ch 3, in first ch:  
(dc, hdc, sl st), FO

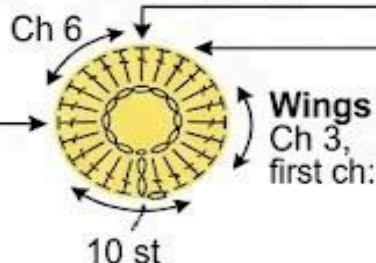

**Body (Yellow/Black)**  
Start MR  
**Rnd 1:** 6 sc in MR  
**Rnd 2:** inc (2 sc) in each sc (12)  
**Rnd 3:** 6 sc in MR  
**Rnd 4:** k (2 sc) in each sc (12)  
**Rnd 5:** i(2 sc) in each sc (12)  
**Rnd 3-8:** 6 sc. (1, 3 sc)  
6. dec (1, 4 sc)  
7. dec. (1, 3+4 sc (+4))  
8. dec (1, 2 s)



- MR Magic Ring
- Ch Chain
- Sl st Stitch
- Sc Single Crochet
- Dc Double Crochet
- Hdc Half Double Crochet
- Sc2tog Decrease
- Inc Sc Increase - 2 sc in same st
- FO** Fasten Off
- Rnd** Round
- St** Stitch

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## **Materials You Will Need**

Before starting, gather all your supplies:

- Cotton yarn in:
  - Yellow
  - Black
  - White (for wings)
  - Green (or preferred color for cords)
- Crochet hook (recommended: 2.5 mm – 3.5 mm)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Stitch marker (optional but helpful)

## **Understanding Abbreviations (US Terms)**

Make sure you are familiar with these stitches:

- MR – Magic Ring
- ch – chain
- sl st – slip stitch
- sc – single crochet
- dc – double crochet
- hdc – half double crochet
- inc – increase (2 sc in same stitch)
- dec – decrease (sc2tog)
- FO – fasten off

## **How to Crochet the Single Bee Motif**

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This is the main decorative element of the bracelet.

### **Body (Yellow & Black)**

Start with yellow yarn.

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#### **Round 1:**

Make a MR, work 6 sc inside the ring (6)

**Round 2:**

Inc in each stitch around (12)

**Round 3:**

Sc in each stitch (12)

**Round 4 (color change begins):**

(Sc 3, change color) repeat around → keep total (12)

**Round 5:**

(Sc 4, change color) repeat (12)

**Round 6:**

(Sc 3, change color) repeat (12)

**Round 7:**

(Sc 4, change color) repeat (13 stitches indicated in diagram flow)

**Round 8:**

(Sc 2, dec) repeat around (12)

**Round 9:**

(Sc 7, dec, sc) → (22 stitches total per diagram shaping)

Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing if needed.

💡 Tip: Alternate yellow and black to create the bee stripes exactly as shown.

## **How to Crochet the Wings (Make 2 per Bee)**

Using white yarn:

- Ch 3
- In the first chain:
  - 1 dc
  - 1 hdc
  - 1 sl st
- FO and leave a small tail

Make **two wings** and attach them to the top of the bee body.

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## **How to Crochet the Tie-Bee Motif (Alternative Bee Style)** <https://craftsforlove.com/> **SEE THE BEST PATTERNS**

This version is slightly flatter and used in the bracelet layout.

### **Body (Yellow/Black)**

**Start:** MR

**Round 1:**

6 sc in MR (6)

**Round 2:**

Inc in each stitch (12)

**Round 3:**

6 sc (maintain shape as shown)

**Round 4:**

(2 sc, inc) repeat (12)

**Round 5:**

(2 sc, inc) repeat (12)

**Rounds 6–8:**

- Round 6: sc around (12)
- Round 7: dec pattern (1, 4 sc) shaping
- Round 8: final shaping (1, 2 sc)

FO.

**Wings for Tie-Bee** <https://craftsforlove.com/> **SEE THE BEST PATTERNS**

- Ch 3
- Work into first chain to form a small circular wing shape
- Total: 10 stitches forming a round detail

Attach to the body.

## **How to Make the Tie-On Cords**

Using green yarn:

- Ch 40 (this creates the tie length)
- Work back along the chain:
  - sl st or sc evenly along

At both ends:

- Create a small loop:
  - ch 1, sl st into base
- FO

## How to Crochet the Bracelet Base

### Foundation:

- Ch 15

### Row 1:

- Sc across the chain

This forms the central band where bees will be attached.

## Assembling the Bracelet

Now bring everything together:

1. Attach one tie cord to each end of the bracelet band
2. Position your bees evenly across the bracelet
3. Between each bee:
  - Ch 6 to create spacing
4. Sew or crochet bees onto the band securely
5. Attach wings to each bee (top center)

 You can use a yarn needle or crochet them directly onto the chain spaces.

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## Finishing Touches

- Weave in all loose ends
- Adjust spacing if needed
- Lightly block if you want a more polished look

## Final Result

You'll have a **beautiful handmade bee bracelet** with:

- Adorable striped bee motifs
- Delicate wings
- Adjustable tie-on cords
