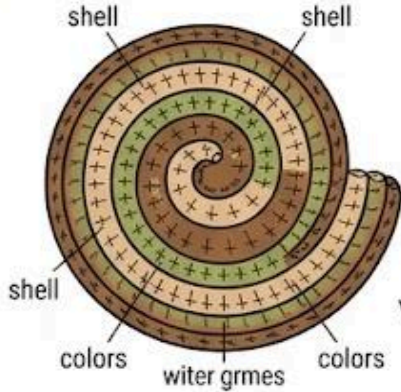


Crocheted Turtle Bracelet – Pattern

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TECHNICAL CROCHET DIAGRAM: AMIGURUMI TURTLE BRACELET (US TERMINOLOGY)

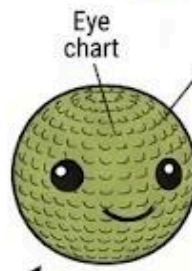
1 Turtle Body & Shell Assembly



Continuous spiral sc chart

- Rnd 1: MR, 6 sc
- Rnd 2: 6 inc...
- Rnd 3: 6 inc. sc, sc inc.
- Rnd 4: 6 sc, sc inc.
- Rnd 5: 4 sc, sc inc.
- Rnd 6: 5 sc (sc)
- Stuffing: Stuffer. FO.

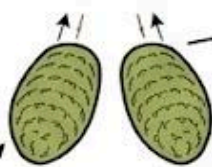
3 3D amigurumi sphere



Sphere chart:

- Rnd 1: 8 sc
- Rnd 2: 4 sc (sc)
- Rnd 3-5 sc (sc)
- Rnd 4-8 sc (dec rounds)
- Rnd 5-6 sc (dec rounds)
- Rnd 7-7 s dec rounds)
- Rnd 1-8: 6 sc
- Stuffing. FO.

2 Turtle Legs (Green)



Leg: (Make 4)
Chain 3, 4 tr in first chain. FO.

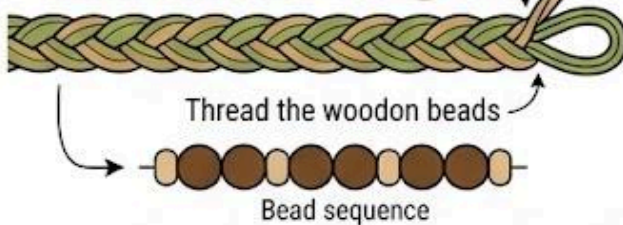

3 Braceleted Base

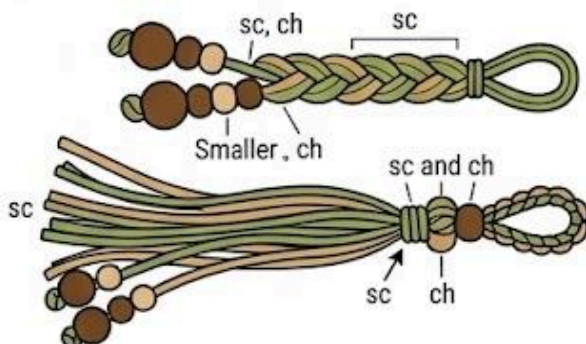
Key: Braid type <>
+ Thread woodon beads



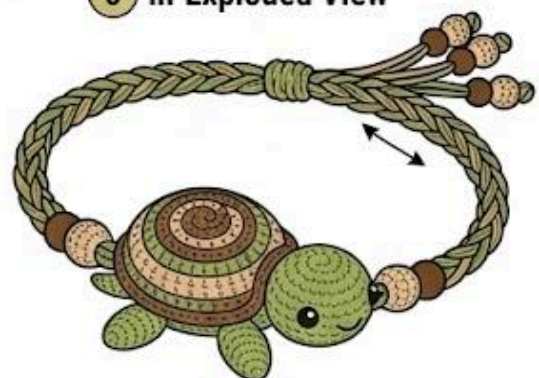
5 Beads

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Materials & Tools

Gather everything before starting:

- Yarn:
 - Green (head, legs)
 - Brown tones (shell)
 - Neutral/green mix (bracelet braid)
- Crochet hook: 2.5 mm – 3.5 mm
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Wooden beads (various sizes)
- Stitch marker (optional)

Abbreviations (US Terms)

- MR = magic ring
- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- inc = increase (2 sc in same stitch)
- dec = decrease (sc2tog)
- FO = fasten off

Step 1: Shell (Top Spiral Piece)

The shell is worked in a **continuous spiral**.

1. Start with **MR**
2. Round 1: 5 sc in MR
3. Round 2: 6 inc (12 sts)
4. Round 3: (*sc, inc*) repeat around
5. Round 4: (*6 sc, inc*)
6. Round 5: (*4 sc, inc*)
7. Round 6: 5 sc around

You will see a **spiral forming naturally**.

Lightly stuff the shell to keep its rounded shape.

FO and set aside.



Step 2: Bottom Shell / Body Base

1. Create a second flat piece similar to the shell base:
 - MR, 6 sc
 - Increase evenly for 3–4 rounds until it matches shell size
2. Do NOT stuff this piece
3. This will be used to close the shell later



Step 3: Head (3D Amigurumi Sphere)

Using green yarn:

1. MR, 8 sc
2. Round 2: 4 inc (12 sts)
3. Round 3: 5 sc
4. Round 4–8: sc around (build height)
5. Round 5–6: maintain stitch count
6. Round 7–8: begin slight decreases if needed for shaping

Insert safety eyes between rounds 4–5.

Stuff firmly.

7. Final round: 6 sc
8. FO, leaving a long tail for sewing



Step 4: Legs (Make 4)

Using green yarn:

1. ch 3
2. Work **4 sc in first chain**
3. Shape into a small oval
4. FO, leaving tail for sewing

Make **4 identical legs**



Step 5: Assemble Turtle Body

1. Place the **head at the front of the shell**
2. Sew securely using yarn needle
3. Attach **4 legs evenly** under the shell
4. Align symmetrically:
 - 2 front legs
 - 2 back legs
5. Place bottom shell piece under top shell
6. Sew edges together
7. Add light stuffing before closing completely

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Step 6: Bracelet Base (Braided Cord)

This creates the wearable bracelet.

1. Cut **multiple long strands of yarn**
2. Divide into 3 equal groups
3. Braid tightly to desired length

Optional:

- Mix colors for a natural look
- 4. Tie knots at both ends to secure



Step 7: Add Wooden Beads

1. Thread beads onto the braid:
 - Follow a **balanced sequence**
 - Place near ends and center
2. Secure beads with knots on each side

This prevents movement.



Step 8: Attach Turtle to Bracelet

1. Position turtle at center of braid
2. Sew underside of shell to braid
3. Make multiple passes for durability

Ensure it sits flat and centered.



Step 9: Tassel & Closure

Loop Side:

1. Create a loop using yarn:
 - ch and sl st to form a ring
2. Reinforce with sc stitches

1. Cut multiple strands of yarn
2. Fold in half and attach to end
3. Add beads if desired
4. Tie securely

This creates a **loop-and-tassel closure**

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Step 10: Final Finishing

1. Weave in all ends carefully
2. Adjust braid and beads
3. Shape turtle:
 - Slightly press shell
 - Align head and legs



Final Size

- Adjustable bracelet length
- Turtle size: small, wearable charm
