





## Materials & Preparation

Use medium weight yarn (Category 4). Suggested colors:

- Gold, yellow, and brown (Cogsworth & Lumière)
- White, pink, and purple (Mrs. Potts & Chip)
- Black, red, and pink embroidery thread

Tools:

- 4.0 mm (G) crochet hook
- Stitch markers (VERY important for rounds)
- Tapestry needle
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Scissors

Tip: Keep your stitches tight to avoid stuffing showing through.



## Stitch Guide (Important Before Starting)

- MR = Magic Ring (adjustable loop)
- sc = single crochet
- inc = 2 sc in same stitch
- dec = invisible decrease (insert hook in front loops of next 2 stitches)
- hdc, dc, tr = taller stitches for shaping
- sl st = slip stitch (used for finishing or joining)
- ch = chain
- picot = ch 3, sl st into first chain
- tr-cluster = yarn over twice, partially complete multiple stitches, then close together

Always work in continuous rounds unless told otherwise.

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# Cogsworth Clock – FULL BUILD



## Main Body Structure

This is the core and largest piece.

Round 1: MR, 6 sc

Round 2: inc in all stitches (12)

Round 3: (sc, inc) repeat (18)

Round 4: (2 sc, inc) repeat (24)

Round 5: (3 sc, inc) repeat (30)

Round 6: (4 sc, inc) repeat (36)

Rounds 7–11: sc in each stitch (36)

Now shaping:

Round 12: (4 sc, dec) repeat (30)

Round 13: (3 sc, dec) repeat (24)

Start stuffing firmly but not overstuffed

Round 14: (2 sc, dec) repeat (18)

Round 15: (sc, dec) repeat (12)

Close and fasten off



## Decorative Top Frame

Attach yarn to top edge:

- Work hdc evenly around
- Add picot every 3 stitches for ornamental look
- Create arches using chains (ch 5, skip 2 stitches, sl st)

This creates the classic Cogsworth crown shape 👑



## Side Gears (Make 2)

Round 1: MR, 6 sc

Round 2: inc (12)

Round 3: (sc, inc) (18)

Add surface slip stitches or embroidery to mimic gear texture.

Attach to both sides of body.

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## **Base / Feet**

Row 1: ch 16  
Row 2: sc across  
Row 3: hdc across

Make 2 flat pieces and attach under the body for stability.

## **Cogsworth Face (IMPORTANT DETAIL SECTION)**


Round 1: MR, 6 sc  
Round 2: inc (12)  
Round 3: (sc, inc) (18)  
Round 4–6: sc evenly

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.

### **Face Embroidery Guide:**

- Eyes: two small black ovals
- Eyebrows: slightly angled (gives expression)
- Nose: tiny stitch or knot
- Mouth: curved line

### **Clock Hands:**

- Use black yarn
- Stitch one short and one long hand
- Angle slightly for personality 

## **Pendulum Chain**

- ch 10–12
- sl st back across
- Attach a small crocheted circle at the end

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## Lumière – FULL STRUCTURE



### Base Stand

Round 1: MR, 6 sc

Round 2: inc (12)

Round 3: (sc, inc) (18)

Rounds 4–7: sc evenly

Round 8: (sc, dec) (12)

Stuff lightly



### Stem Body

Continue upward:

Rounds 9–14: sc evenly

Add slight increases if needed to match diagram shape



### Arms (Make 2 identical curved pieces)

ch 18–22

Row 1: sc across

Row 2: hdc across

Bend gently while stitching to body to create curve.



### Candle Cups

Round 1: MR, 6 sc

Round 2: inc (12)

Round 3–5: sc

Make 3 total (2 arms + 1 top)

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## **Flames**

Using yellow yarn:


- ch 5
- sl st back
- add picot at tip

Attach to candle tops

## **Lumière Faces**

Make 2 small circles:  
MR, 6 sc → inc (12)

Embroider:

- One smiling face
- One winking face 

## **Mrs. Potts – FULL TEAPOT**

### **Main Body (Round and Wide)**

Round 1: MR, 6 sc

Round 2: inc (12)

Round 3: (sc, inc) (18)

Round 4: (2 sc, inc) (24)

Round 5: (3 sc, inc) (30)

Round 6: (4 sc, inc) (36)

Rounds 7–12: sc evenly

Round 13: (4 sc, dec) (30)

Round 14: (3 sc, dec) (24)

Stuff firmly

Round 15: (2 sc, dec) (18)

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## Lid

Round 1: MR, 6 sc

Round 2: inc (12)

Rounds 3–5: sc

Add decorative:

- dc, ch 1, skip stitch pattern
- picot edges

## Spout

ch 10

Row 1: sc

Row 2: inc at one side to create angle

Attach tilted slightly upward

## Handle

ch 14

Row 1: sc

Row 2: sc

Shape into curved arch before sewing

## Face

- Big eyes with lashes
- Small nose
- Smile
- Pink blush (lightly embroidered or fabric paint)

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## **Chip Teacup – FULL BUILD**

### **Cup Body**

Round 1: MR, 6 sc

Round 2: inc (12)

Round 3: (sc, inc) (18)

Round 4: (2 sc, inc) (24)

Rounds 5–9: sc evenly

Fasten off

### **Rim**

Attach yarn:

- 1 round of hdc
- optional: reverse single crochet for neat edge

### **Handle**

ch 6

Row 1–2: sc

Attach to side

### **Face Placement**

- Eyes centered slightly lower than middle
- Smile wide and soft
- Add blush circles

### **Final Assembly (VERY IMPORTANT)**

1. Always pin pieces before sewing
2. Sew using whip stitch or mattress stitch
3. Align faces BEFORE final stitching
4. Stuff gradually to avoid lumps
5. Hide all yarn tails inside

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## 🌟 Pro Tips for Best Results

- Keep stitch tension consistent across all pieces
- Use invisible decreases for cleaner look
- If shapes warp, adjust hook size slightly
- Embroidery defines personality—take your time
- Blocking (light steaming) helps final shape
