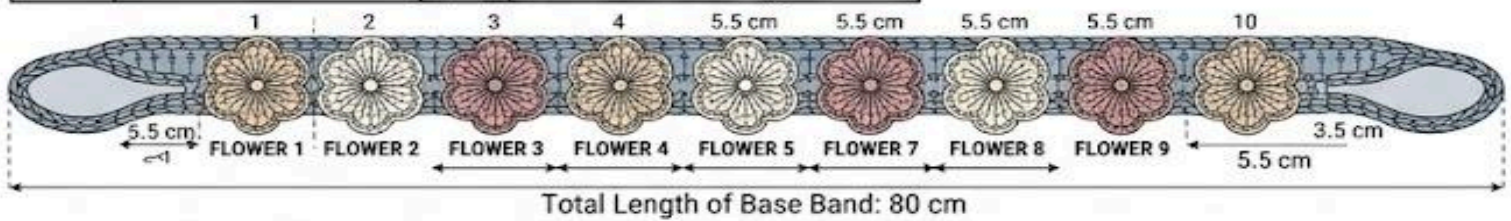
FULL TECHNICAL CROCHET DIAGRAM: FLORAL HEADBAND / PET COLLAR (US TERMS)

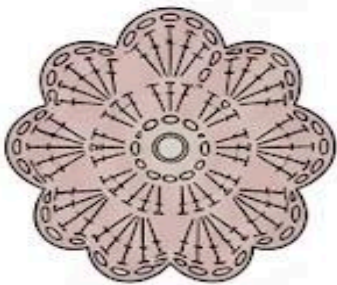
YARN COLOR KEY

STEP-BY-STEP BREAKDOWN:

1. FLOWER PATTERN



Round 1:
Magic circle, 10 sc
Round 2 (Petals):
*ch 3, 2 dc in next st,
ch 3, sl st in next st*

2. BASE BAND CONSTRUCTION

Row 1 (Foundation): 78 ch (or length appropriate for a complete item), ch 3 turning chain



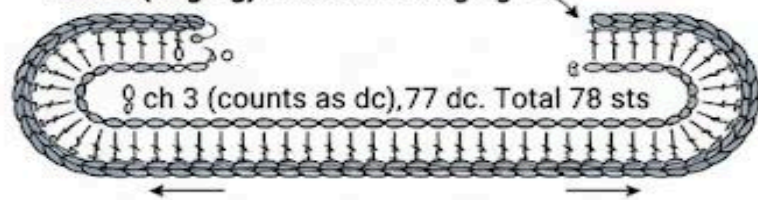
Row 2-7: Repeating Rows of dc stitches

Row 5-6: ch 3 (counts as dc), 77 dc. Total 78 sts

Row 2-7: ch 3 (counts as dc), 77 dc. Total 78 sts

Row 6: ch 3 (counts as dc), 77 dc. Total 78 sts

Row 8 (Edging): all-around edging



2. BASE BAND CONSTRUCTION

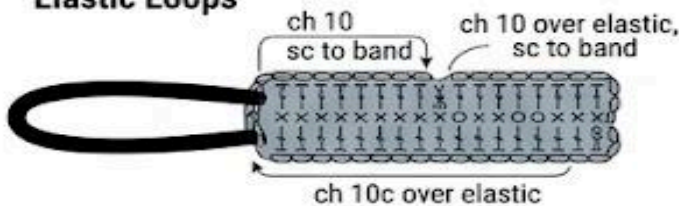
Yarn A: Dust Blue

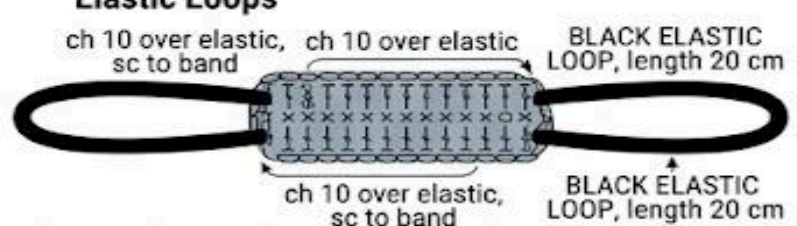

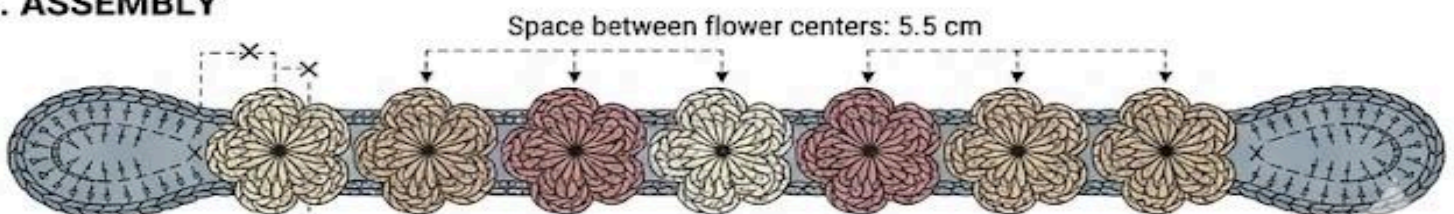

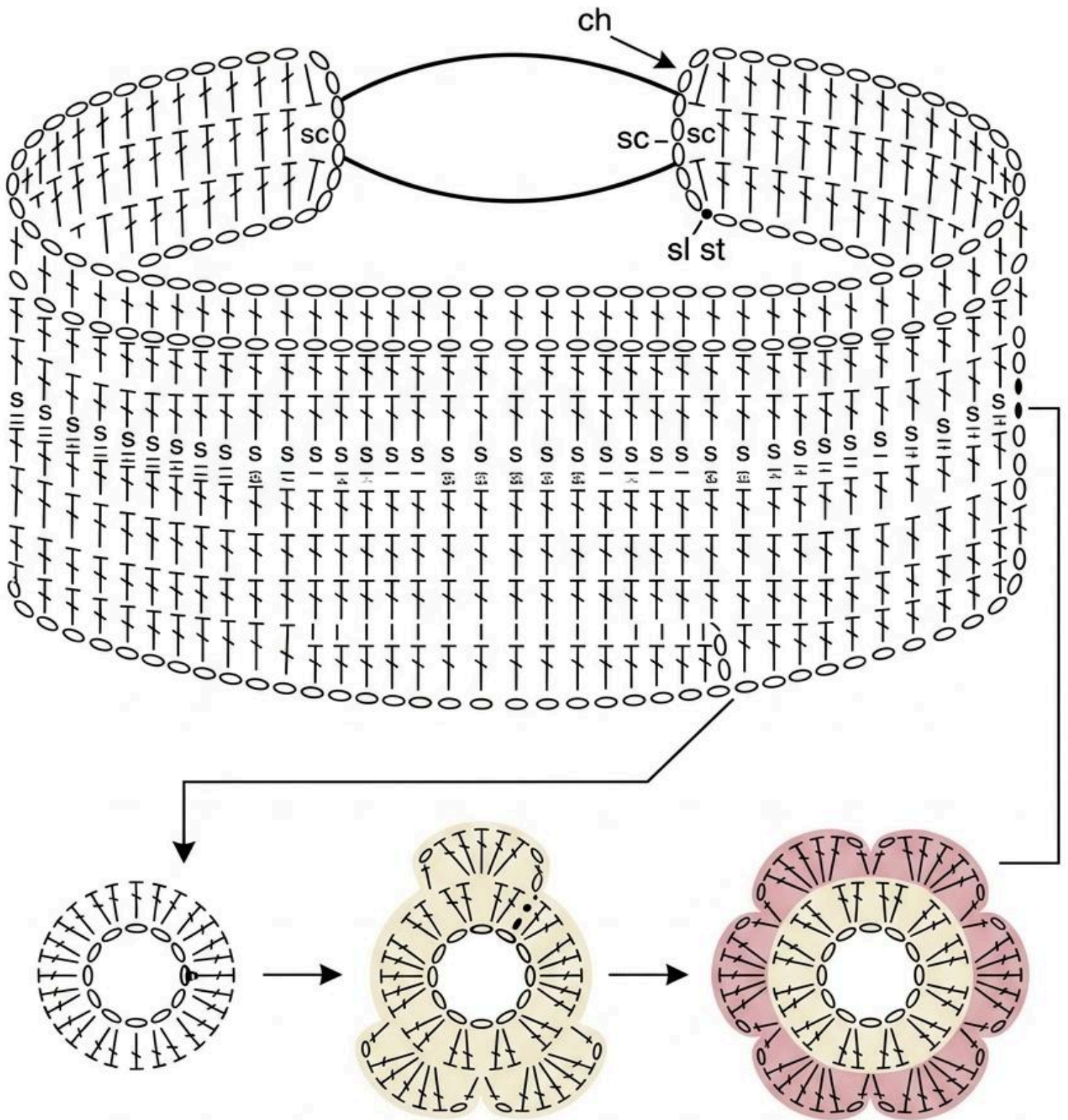

3. ASSEMBLY



Apply full sequence of 11 flowers as numbered



ch = chain
sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
sl st = slip stitch

Materials

- Yarn A: Dust Blue (Base Band)
- Yarn B: Cream
- Yarn C: Dusty Rose
- Yarn D: Beige
- Crochet hook (3.5–4.5 mm recommended)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Measuring tape
- Black elastic: **2 pieces, 20 cm each**

Crochet Terms (US)

- Magic Circle (MC)
- Chain (ch)
- Slip Stitch (sl st)
- Single Crochet (sc)
- Double Crochet (dc)

Step 1: Flower Pattern (Make 11 Flowers)

Each flower is worked in **2 rounds only**, exactly as shown in the diagram.

Round 1 (Center)

- Make a **magic circle**
- Work **10 sc into the circle**
- Join with **sl st** in the first stitch

 Total: **10 stitches**

Round 2 (Petals)

Repeat this sequence around:

- *ch 3
- 2 dc in next stitch
- ch 3
- sl st in next stitch*

Repeat until all stitches are used.

 You will form **rounded petals evenly around the flower**

✓ Important Notes

- Each flower uses the same structure
- Make a total of **11 flowers**
- Follow the **color sequence exactly as in the diagram (symmetrical layout)**



Step 2: Base Band Construction

Row 1 (Foundation)

- Chain **78 stitches**
- Add **ch 3 (counts as first dc)**

Rows 2–7 (Main Band)

For each row:

- ch 3 (counts as dc)
- Work **1 dc in each stitch across**



Each row = **78 dc total**



Repeat until you have **6 rows of dc**

Row 8 (Edging – Worked All Around)

- Work evenly around the entire band
- Continue placing dc stitches along edges



Maintain consistent spacing



Final count per long side: **78 stitches**



Step 3: Elastic Loops (Both Ends)

Each side is identical.

Instructions:

- Insert elastic (20 cm length)
- *ch 10 over the elastic*
- Attach back to band with **sc**
- Continue working **ch 10 over elastic, sc to band** across the width



This secures the elastic into the band



Repeat on the other side

Step 4: Assembly

Placement

- Lay the band flat
- Position flowers along the center line
- Keep **5.5 cm between flower centers**

Attaching Flowers

- Sew each flower securely using yarn needle
- Stitch through the center of each flower
- Make sure alignment is straight and evenly spaced

➔ Attach all **11 flowers in sequence**

Final Measurements (From Diagram)

- Total base band length: **80 cm**
- Flower spacing: **5.5 cm between centers**
- Elastic loops: **20 cm each**

Accuracy Tips (Important)

- Count stitches every row (**must remain 78**)
- Keep flower size consistent
- Do not skip stitches in Round 2 petals
- Maintain exact spacing for professional finish
- Keep tension even to match measurements

Final Result

You will have a **floral crochet headband / pet collar** that is:

- Structured and durable
- Flexible due to elastic loops
- Symmetrical and decorative
- Exactly matching the original diagram

DETAILED CROCHET HAIRBAND TUTORIAL: FROM START TO FINISH

MATERIALS & TOOLS



YARN

Medium-weight cotton (grey blue cream/white, dusty rose, light beige)



CROCHET HOOK
G/4mm & H/5mm



BLACK ELASTIC HAIR TIE



TAPESTRY NEEDLE



SCISSORS

US CROCHET TERMS GLOSSARY

ch (Chain): YO, pull through loop.

sc (Single Crochet): Insert hook, YO, pull up loop (2 loops on hook), YO, pull through both loops.

dc (Double Crochet): YO, insert hook, YO, pull up loop (3 loops on hook), YO, pull through 2 loops, YO, next sc times, YO, pull through remaining 2 loops.

tr (Treble Crochet): YO twice, insert hook, YO, pull up loop (4 loops on hook), YO, pull through 2 loops (repeat 2 times), YO, pull through remaining 2 loops.

sl st (Slip Stitch): Insert hook, YO, pull through all loops.

YO (Yarn Over)



Magic Ring Rnd 1 &



Rnd 1 & Rnd 1 & 2

STEP 1: MAKE THE BASE BAND (GREY-BLUE)



Ch 55 (or desired length).
Row 1: DC in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across.
Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next dc and in each dc across. Finish with a sl st to form a loop.



Detail photo of the finished grey-blue ring on the elastic.

STEP 2: ATTACH TO ELASTIC



Overlap the ends of the grey-blue crochet band. Secure them around the black elastic hair tie using slip stitches or a yarn needle to form a loop.



STEP 3: CROCHET THE FLOWERS



FLOWER A (DUSTY ROSE)

Start with Magic Ring or Ch 4 and
Rnd 1: Ch 1, 10 sc in ring, Sl St.
Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), 4 dc in same stitch, ch 3, Sl St (forms one petal). (Sk next sc c, ch 3, Sl St) 4 times. Sl St to join.



FLOWER B (CREAM)

Same Rnd 1 as Flower A.
Rnd 2: (Sk next sc, 5 tr in next sc, ch 1, Sl St) 4 times.



FLOWER C (BEGE/MIX)

Similar technique to Flower A but with a beige center and cream. Shows slight variation.



STEP 4: ASSEMBLY

- Map the flower sequence on your band. Alternate colors and designs. Example: Rose, Cream, Rose, Cream, Bege.
- Use a tapestry needle to sew the back of each flower firmly onto the base band.
- Detail photo of multiple flowers sewn in place, showing the alignment seen in <IMAGE-O>.



STEP 5: FINISHING



Weave in all remaining yarn tails with the tapestry needle for a clean finish. Secure with a knot if needed.
