



Materials & Preparation

Before starting, gather:

- Yarn:
 - Color A (Cream) – main wings
 - Color B (Silver/Grey or Pink) – edging + flower
 - Color C (for antennae)
- Crochet hook (recommended: 2.5 mm – 3.5 mm depending on yarn)
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

Abbreviations (US Terms)

- MR = Magic Ring
- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- dc = double crochet
- tr = triple crochet
- cl = cluster stitch



Step 1: Making the Body

The body uses a **multi-strand cord technique**.

1. Cut multiple strands of yarn (Color A).
2. Fold them in half and secure the top.
3. Begin braiding tightly to form a narrow cord.
4. Continue until the body reaches the desired length (as shown in diagram proportions).
5. Tie off securely at the bottom.
6. Shape slightly thicker at the center if desired.

Set aside — you will attach the wings later.

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Step 2: Crochet the Flower Motif

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This small flower is used as decoration on the wings.

Round 1 (Color A)

1. Start with a **Magic Ring (MR)**
2. Work **5 sc into the ring**
3. Join with **sl st**

Round 2 (Switch to Color B – Pink)

1. *ch 3, dc, cl, dc, ch 3, sl st* in same stitch
2. Repeat from * to * **5 times total**
3. You will form **5 petals**

Fasten off and set aside.



Step 3: Upper Wings (Round 1)

Using **Color A (Cream)**:

1. Attach yarn near the **top of the body**
2. *ch 6*
3. Work stitches along the chain and shape:
 - Use a combination of **dc, tr, and chains** to build the curved wing
4. Follow the diagram structure:
 - Increase stitches toward the outer edge
 - Maintain symmetry on both sides
5. Finish first upper wing
6. Repeat for second side

Do not fasten off if continuing to edging.



Step 4: Upper Wings (Round 2 & Edging)

Switch to **Color B (Silver/Grey)**:

1. Work around the edge of each wing
2. Use:
 - *cl* (cluster stitches)
 - *ch* spaces
 - *sl st* to anchor
3. Create scalloped edges:
 - Alternate clusters and chains to form soft curves

4. At each tip:
 - Add extra stitches to emphasize the wing points

Fasten off neatly.

Step 5: Lower Wings (Round 1)

Using **Color A (Cream)**:

1. Attach yarn slightly below the upper wings on the body
2. Begin with **ch 66 foundation**
3. Work into the chain:
 - sc, dc, tr combinations to shape the lower wing
4. Form two rounded sections:
 - Upper part (smaller curve)
 - Lower part (larger, fuller curve)

Repeat symmetrically on both sides.

Step 6: Lower Wings (Round 2 & Edging)

Switch to **Color B (Silver/Grey)**:

1. Work edging around the entire lower wing
2. Use:
 - clusters (cl)
 - chains
 - slip stitches
3. Add decorative scallops along the edge
4. Keep spacing consistent for a balanced look

Fasten off.

Step 7: Attach the Flower Motifs

1. Take your prepared flower pieces
2. Position them on the lower wings (as shown in diagram)
3. Sew securely using yarn needle
4. Make sure placement is symmetrical

Step 8: Antennae

Using **Color C**: <https://craftsforlove.com/> **SEE THE BEST PATTERNS**

1. Attach yarn at the top of the body
2. ch 10
3. sl st back along the chain
4. Repeat for second antenna

Optional: Add small decorative knots or mini shapes at the tips.

Step 9: Final Assembly

1. Ensure all wings are securely attached to the body
2. Adjust shape:
 - Gently stretch wings for symmetry
3. Weave in all ends carefully
4. Block lightly if needed for a polished finish

Final Result

You now have a **beautiful Cherry Blossom Butterfly** crochet piece  

It can be used as:

- Appliqué for bags or clothing
- Wall decoration
- Hair accessory
- Gift embellishment

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
