


## PATCHWORK DOG QUILT BLOCK & FINISHING TUTORIAL

### STAGE 1: MATERIALS & CUTTING LIST (All in CM)





<p><b>Fabric A (Assorted Prints)</b> 6.5 cm x 6.5 cm (finished 5 cm)</p>  <p><b>Fabric C (White)</b> • 6.5 cm x 6.5 cm (WOF) • 1.5 cm x 6.5 cm (WOF) • 6.5 cm x 6.5 cm (WOF)</p>	<p><b>Fabric B (Black)</b> 6.5 cm x 13 cm</p>  <p><b>Fabric D (Lining/Backing)</b></p> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; width: fit-content; margin: 5px auto;"> <p>D Backing: 60 cm x 70 cm Batting: 58 cm x 68 cm</p> </div> 	<p><b>Fabric C (White)</b> • Background strips • Stitch neck white triangles &amp; 1 neck white patches</p>  <p><b>Fabric E (Border)</b> • 6.5 cm x wide x WOF (WOF) • 6.5 cm x 3 sin x WOF (WOF) • 4.5 cm x 9 wn x WOF (WOF)</p>





### STAGE 2: HEAD & FACE ASSEMBLY

- 1  Join patchwork squares for the head (e.g., 3 cm x 6.5 cm (finished 5 cm)).
- 2  Fold and stitch black ear rectangles to create trapezoidal shape. Press.
- 3  Assemble muzzle (white oval), Stitch nose and mouth details with embroidery floss.
- 4  Layer the muzzle and ears with the patchwork head. Do correct placement. Add small black eye buttons.














### STAGE 3: BODY & TAIL ASSEMBLY

- 1  Join patchwork squares for the body grid (o.g., 6x5 grid). Note: correct placement of the "V" neck white triangles.
- 2  Stitch patchwork squares together to form. Pin and stitch tail to body block.
- 3  Form feet with small patchwork blocks.
- 4  Use 1/4 inch (6 mm) seam allowance.

### STAGE 4: QUILT SANDWICH & FINISHING

- 1  Backing, Batting, Quilt Top. Baste all layers using pins or spray basting.
- 2  Attach side borders first, then top and bottom.
- 3  Diagonal Grid Quilting
- 4  Hand-lit fold binding, and create the reverse. Create double-fold binding and hand-stitching it to the reverse.

## Stage 1: Materials & Cutting List

Before starting, gather all your materials and cut your fabrics accurately. Precision here makes everything easier later.

### Fabrics Needed

#### Fabric A (Assorted Prints)

- Cut multiple squares measuring **6.5 cm x 6.5 cm (unfinished)**
- These will form the colorful patchwork sections

#### Fabric B (Black)

- Cut rectangles measuring **6.5 cm x 13 cm**
- Used for the ears

#### Fabric C (White)

- 6.5 cm x 6.5 cm squares (for background and muzzle)
- 11.5 cm x 6.5 cm strips
- Additional 6.5 cm squares for accents

#### Fabric D (Lining/Backing)

- Backing: **60 cm x 70 cm**
- Batting: **58 cm x 68 cm**

#### Fabric E (Border)

- 6.5 cm wide strips (width of fabric)
- 6.5 cm x 3 strips
- 4.5 cm x 8 strips (outer border)

### Tools & Notions

- Cotton thread
- Embroidery floss
- Rotary cutter and ruler
- Self-healing cutting mat
- Sewing machine
- Marking pen or chalk



## Stage 2: Head & Face Assembly

This stage builds the adorable face of your patchwork dog.

## Step 1: Create the Patchwork Head Base

- Sew together small squares (approx. **3 cm x 6.5 cm finished**)
- Arrange in a grid to form a **32 cm block**
- Press seams to one side

## Step 2: Make the Ears

- Take your black rectangles (6.5 x 13 cm)
- Fold and stitch diagonally to form a trapezoid shape
- Trim excess fabric
- Press flat

## Step 3: Assemble the Muzzle

- Cut a white oval shape for the muzzle
- Stitch or applique onto the face
- Use embroidery floss to stitch:
  - Nose
  - Mouth

## Step 4: Build the Face

- Attach ears to the top corners
- Place the muzzle in the center
- Add small black buttons or stitched circles for eyes
- Adjust placement before final stitching

## Stage 3: Body & Tail Assembly

Now let's construct the body and give your dog its personality!

### Step 1: Create the Body Grid

- Sew together patchwork squares into a **6 x 6 grid**
- Leave space at the top for the V-shaped neckline
- Use white triangles to create the "neck"

### Step 2: Make the Tail

- Sew patchwork pieces into a curved tail shape
- Carefully trim and shape
- Stitch tail onto the body block

### Step 3: Form the Legs & Feet <https://craftsforlove.com/> SEE THE BEST PATTERNS

- Use small patchwork blocks for the feet
- Attach them at the bottom of the body
- Ensure alignment before sewing

### Step 4: Assemble the Full Dog

- Attach the head to the body
- Align carefully and sew with a  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam allowance (6 mm)
- Press seams flat

## Stage 4: Quilt Sandwich & Finishing

This is where your quilt comes together and becomes a finished piece!

### Step 1: Create the Quilt Sandwich

Layer in this order:

1. Backing (right side down)
2. Batting (centered)
3. Quilt top (right side up)

Secure layers using:

- Pins
- Or basting spray

### Step 2: Add Borders

- Sew side borders first
- Then attach top and bottom borders
- Press seams outward

### Step 3: Quilting

- Use a **diagonal grid quilting pattern**
- Stitch evenly across the quilt
- You can also quilt “in-the-ditch” along seams

### Step 4: Binding & Finishing

- Create double-fold binding strips
- Attach binding to the front
- Fold over to the back
- Hand stitch neatly to finish

## **Stitching & Quilting Methods**

### **Stitching Techniques**

- Quarter-inch seam allowance
- Edge stitching for precision
- Press seams after every step

### **Quilting Options**

- Diagonal grid (recommended for this pattern)
- Stitch-in-the-ditch
- Free-motion quilting (optional)

### **Finishing Techniques**

- Mitered corners for clean edges
- Hand-finished binding
- Optional blocking for a perfect shape

## **Final Tips for Success**

- Always measure twice before cutting
- Press seams frequently for accuracy
- Lay out pieces before sewing to avoid mistakes
- Take your time with the face details—they bring your dog to life 🐾
